



Home learning/ test

- Each pupil has regular home learning on a different topic each half term.
- Home learning will be handed out every 2 weeks, allowing 1 week for it to be completed.
- Tasks will be involve a research task, practical application task and a worksheet test completed in college.
- Further extension tasks are possible to pupils
- Stop watch picture shows guideline of time on task
- Home learning will reviewed and discussed in the hand in lessons

Home learning / test

- On home learning either not being attempted or incomplete, the consequences are as follows in each instance:
- 1. First instance –
- With note A 1 lesson extension will be given.
- Without note loss of social time the same day for 20 minutes, a record made on the SIMS system to generate a behaviour point, a record made on the SIMS learning gateway against the home learning log and a phone call home to inform parents.
- 2. Second instance As above
- 3. Third instance Faculty report will be issued and a further phone call home made.

PE Setting

The first four lessons will involve assessments to determine your PE sets for the rest of year 7 as well as a fitness suite induction.

After these lessons, boys will begin Rugby and girls Netball for a few weeks before they mix again in the newly formed PE sets
