A trip to the Armed Forces Careers Offices (AFCO) in Plymouth proved very successful with students meeting Royal Navy (Marine) personnel in a real working environment. Home of the tri-service recruiting offices the AFCO is full of information and guidance for those interested in a career within the Armed forces.

The visit included an attempt at the Royal Navy psychometric testing papers. A pre entry test that all recruits must pass. A massive 86% pass rate by our students who received some fantastic feedback and for some- a list of possible job opportunities should they wish to use this result for real
