Computing Club

Thursday after school : 3.20pm - 4.45pm IT2

An opportunity to explore areas of interest including programming, Raspberry Pi's, Lego NXT robotics and Logicator Control Systems. Open to all years this is supported activity time with students selecting their own areas for study.

Programming Boosters & Revision

Tuesday after school: 3.20pm - 4.45pm IT1

Aimed at GCSE students who would benefit from some extra time and support with their programming work. While we absolutely cannot offer specific help for the programming controlled assessment we can provide practice activities and help outside the CA context. This can be through individually tailored or group based guided activities. May be of interest to Year 11 students considering A Level Computing who have not gone through the GCSE programme or Year 11 students who would like some individual support with their revision programme.

Thinking Space every lunchtime: IT1

IT1 is open every lunchtime for any student who wants access to a computer for constructive activity; this includes home learning, private projects, programming, creative digital work or anything else that promotes independent thinking, problem solving and creativity. Please note playing games, watching videos and listening to music do not qualify! These sessions are informally supervised – Mrs Neill is usually present but often eating her lunch or working at the same time!

We have a Raspberry Pi hub with 6 networked Pi's. These are available for Minecraft Programming (note - programming, not playing!) and for building and programming electronic projects.


