

SNOWSPORT TRIP 2017

Dear Parents/Carers

This is the final letter confirming all the details for the above trip and to ensure your son/daughter is fully prepared and organised for the departure on Saturday 11th February 2017.

Outbound Details

- Meeting at Tavistock College at 9:15am ready for 9:45am pick-up – Saturday 11th February 2017
- Arrival in Claviere at approximately 11am - Sunday 12th February 2017

Inbound Details

- Depart at 3pm after lunch – Saturday 18th February 2017
- Arrival back at Tavistock College at approximately 2pm - Sunday 19th February 2017

Students are allowed only **one piece** of medium/large sized **soft suitcase** for clothing and skiwear*. All valuables, personal belongings and necessities for the journey (food, drinks, money – pound sterling and euro, toiletries)* should be carried in a small rucksack which can also be taken out for the day when skiing. Bear in mind that space is limited and we would like students to be as comfortable as possible on such a long journey.

During the journey it is advisable to wear comfortable, loose clothing. **The hoodie supplied must be worn for both the outbound and inbound journey.** A pillow and a fleece blanket for overnight on the coach are also advisable.

The coach is equipped with a DVD player and students are welcome to bring films to watch but must be aware that they must have a certificate of 15 or under.

Passport and EHIC card will be checked prior to departure. The refundable €5 deposit, in an envelope clearly labelled with your son/daughter name and tutor group on it, will be collected during passport and EHIC card checks.

If your son/daughter is on any medication please, make sure you supply them with enough medication for the duration of the trip. Also the trip leader or any accompanying member of staff needs to be aware of it. Please also be reminded we cannot administer any medication i.e. paracetamol or ibuprofen.

All personal belongings, valuables, money, passport, EHIC card etc. are the responsibility of the student.
