


# Important Dates

## ▶ Foundation

- Grade 1 = 15%
- Grade 2 = 25%
- Grade 3 = 42%
- Grade 4 = 55%
- Grade 5 = 70%

## ▶ Higher

- Grade 4 = 25%
- Grade 5 = 35%
- Grade 6 = 45%
- Grade 7 = 59%
- Grade 8 = 70%
- Grade 9 = 84%
