# RESORT DESCRIPTION

---

- Artesina is situated in Piedmont, Italy – 107Km from Turin.
- The ski resort is pretty “young” as it was only built in the sixties by a group of businessmen who wanted to capitalise on the popularity of skiing in the region.
- As a ski resort, it is an excellent area. Artesina is at a height of 1400 metres, with the top of the slopes at 2085 metres.
- Artesina is part of the Mondolé ski area comprising of three ski areas: Artesina, Prato Nevoso and Frabosa Soprana. All three areas are covered under the same lift pass, offering guests the opportunity for a great variety of skiing and snowboarding.
- The layout of the skiing area means there is good progression from the beginner slopes to the intermediate level, and beyond.
