

Fine Art Summer work: Responding to your Personal Space

Part One (Practical work)

Fill an A4 (or bigger) sketchbook recording your time between now and results day. Treat it as a journal of yourself and the things around you.

Your work could be drawing, painting, a collection of found images, or a combination. The most obvious resource is yourself, so self portraits are a good place to start.

You can research artists work and make copies of their work to help you to develop your drawing and painting skills. You may work in 3D, but make sure you make a record with a camera, with drawing and with annotation.

Part Two (Research)

Find an image by Larry Rivers an early American Pop Artist



Write a **brief** paragraph about the Rivers and another paragraph about your thoughts on the painting you have chosen. It is important to talk about the elements of art.
