How the subject will be taught:

A range of strategies are used in Business. These include individual note taking, group work and presentations, discussions, problem solving exercises, quiz tests and assessments at the end of every topic area. Due to the numerical content some lessons will involve calculations and numerical activities.

Lessons are often based around real businesses and reflect the word around us. There is also a focus on developing exam technique from the beginning of year 12 and end of topic assessments will include exam style questions. Planning sheets and exemplar answers are used to help develop understanding.
