

Assessment

- There are 2 external exams with are set by BTEC for 2 of the core units. All the remaining units of study are assessed through internal set assignments.
- In order to complete the course you must pass all pass criteria.



WHO WOULD BE INTERESTED IN THIS COURSE?

- If you enjoy working with people/ have an interest in science/ health/education then this might be the course for you. (girls and boys)
- It is a level 3 qualification- equivalent to 1 A' Levels and draws UCAS points
- It is a vocational qualification which means you use your knowledge and skills learnt in school and transfer them for use within the workplace.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- The entry requirements for the level 3 health & social care are:-
- 5 GCSE's grade 4/5 or above including English and Maths (you may be able to resit Maths if you got below a 4/5' grade.)



A clean DBS check

- Since 2002 the criminal records Bureau (now DBS) has enabled employers to check the criminal records of employers in order to ascertain whether or not they are suitable to work with vulnerable adults and children.
- For most health care professions, for volunteers and employees these DBS checks must be clean.

PROGRESSION ROUTES

- Nursing (you will also need a science A'level)
- Teaching (you must have GCSE's in English, Maths and Science)
- Physiotherapy
- Paramedic (you must have a clean driving licence)
- Dietician (with additional science qualifications)
- Health Care Assistant
- Care Assistant
- Dental Nurse
- NB- if you want to work exclusively with children- you need to study a childcare course
