Dear parent/carer

You will have seen that Tavistock and West Devon have a red weather warning in place for tomorrow morning. This means that there is a significant risk to life and travel is only recommended if it is essential. Closing a school is the last thing I want to do, students have missed so much schooling during the COVID-19 pandemic. I hope that you understand my decision to close the school in order to keep our community safe.
