Trip Check List	
Dress requirements	Students will be representing the college and we therefore request that they are dressed in full school uniform.
Breakfast / mid- morning snack or money	Due to the early start students will need to bring a packed breakfast or mid- morning snack, including enough drink for the day. Alternatively, you can provide your child with cash as we will be stopping for rest breaks at service stations where students will be allowed to purchase food and drink.
Lunch	A packed lunch will be provided by the college.
Dinner / Tea /	Again due to the travelling time students will need a packed dinner / tea or cash
evening snack	to purchase food during rest breaks.
Warm coat	Students might want to bring a warm coat to make the journey more comfortable.
Medication	If your child requires prescribed medication between 6.00am – 10.00pm staff will be on hand with consent forms for you to complete when you drop your child off in the morning. Please note we can only administer prescribed medication with your permission.
Travel sickness	If your child suffers from travel sickness and takes medication before travelling, please can you ensure they know when to take this and pack the required dose only in their bag. A change of clothes are also recommended.
