

HEADSTART 2018 – 2019

'HEADSTART' is an after-school study facility located in the College Library.

'HEADSTART' supports students with their homework, coursework and research by providing:

- Access to study resources
- Access to a study skills tutor
- Computing, printing and photocopying facilities

All students are welcome. A consent form will need to be signed by parents/guardians (attached). Additional forms are available from the Library. Consent forms should be handed in to the Librarian. On HEADSTART evenings, students need to sign in and out. Refreshments will be available free of charge during the sessions.

OPENING TIMES

The facilities will be available from 3.20 until 4.45pm on **Tuesdays and Thursdays** – Late buses will run on days to coincide with 'Headstart' dates, please see dates, times and routes below.

Autumn Term

Sessions commence Tuesday 11th September 2018, and will run each week up to Thursday 20th December 2018.

Please note:

- No sessions during half term week 22nd to 26th October.

Spring Term

Sessions commence Thursday 10th January and run up to Thursday 4th April 2019

Please note:

- No sessions during half term week 18th – 22nd February.
- No sessions over Easter holidays 8th April to 22nd April 2019.

Summer Term

Sessions commence Thursday 25th April and run up to Thursday 11th July 2019.

Please note:

- No sessions over Half Term week 27th May to 31st May 2019

Transport

Late buses will depart from the College car park at 5.00pm [prompt] on the following routes:

Coach 1: Horrabridge (Manor Garage), Yelverton (roundabout), Walkhampton (War Memorial), Dousland (Burrator Inn), Meavy (school), Crapstone (War Memorial), Milton Coombe (turning circle), Buckland Monachorum (Top of village).

Coach 2: Chillaton (square), Milton Abbot (village), Lamerton (school), Chipshop, Bere Alston (fire station), Bere Alston (Edgecombe Hotel), Bere Alston (Church), Bere Ferrers (social club) Lifton (Ambrosia Bridge).

Coach 3: Brentor (Yellands corner), Mary Tavy (Bus Stop), Peter Tavy (square), Postbridge (car park), Princetown (square)

Bus Passes for the late buses will be issued at each session of Headstart, signed and dated by staff. Travel is free but a bus pass is required for each journey, these MUST be handed to the bus driver.
