Recovery Planning using the Covid Catch up Premium tranche 1 - October 2020 - January 2021

Tranche 1 Covid Catch up Funding at Tavistock College - £23,300

Rationale

To capture and prioritise the Covid catch up premium funding spend to enable those students in year 7 and 11 and in most need of recovery learning following missed face to face teaching during the 1st national lockdown from March to July 2020:

- Identification of year 7 missed curricular elements through their KS2 missed face to face teaching.
 - Numeracy
 - Literacy
 - The mental health benefits of PE and school sport developing and understanding self confidence and resilience.
 - Performing arts skills
 - Relationship and Sex Education

Year 7 spent on a collapsed curriculum day to launch these missed elements and resources to support this moving forward into lessons and extracurricular opportunities.

- Identification of Year 11 students that were in need of additional catch up teaching and or resources to develop and recover from missed face to face teaching during lockdown. These identifications were made by HOFs through either misconceptions or non completion of work.
 - IT resources or subscriptions to enable students and teachers to deliver additional support for catch up skills. £ 4,778
 - Targeted physical resources for those students who are more than 2 grades below their target grade due to the missed face to face teaching. £9,465
 - Targeted additional teaching hours (extended day) for those students who are more than 2 grades below their target grades in more than two subjects.
 Total of 384 additional teaching hours £11,520
