### CHALLENGE

#### At Tavistock College

Our curriculum is designed to ensure young people not only develop academic acumen, but are equipped to thrive in a world full of uncertainty and challenge.

Together, we care, we challenge, we excel are our guiding principles in all curriculum decisions at Tavistock College.

Our curriculum is a commitment to:

- Providing an ambitious curriculum for all young people
- 2. Providing an inclusive curriculum, with personalisation of each young person's curriculum so that they are able to study appropriate academic or vocational qualifications
- 3. Ensuring sufficient challenge through the curriculum so that all young people feel stretched and have a curriculum which is appropriate to their ability
- 4. Providing high quality teaching, through subject experts, which supports and complements the curriculum
- 5. Providing a curriculum which enhances young peoples' cultural capital and provides opportunities for personal development. This will be supplemented both within and outside of the classroom through the learning opportunities provided for all



Through the academic and pastoral curriculum young people are given opportunities to explore democracy, rule of law, how government works, freedom, faiths, and acceptance of other cultures. These themes will be embedded across the curriculum.

Young people's social, moral, spiritual and cultural education is key in all areas and our personal development programme helps to develop these skills.


We pride ourselves on our curriculum which develops the whole young person.







Tavistock College is committed to providing a curriculum that is broad and balanced, yet also stretches students of all abilities. All learning is based upon a mastery curriculum with knowledge at the core. Subjects plan their curriculums backwards from KS5 and interleave topics so knowledge and understanding builds over time. The aim of this is to ensure that young people's learning makes clear progression through the college and ensures that young people are stretched to enable them to achieve their potential.





Through our deliberate practice of 'teaching to the top' we are an inclusive school that leaves no young person behind. For students with barriers to learning, scaffolding strategies are put in place to ensure all learners can access content. This is complemented through the SEND department's review sharing of high quality teaching and learning strategies, alongside our creation of Class Plans which supports a Plan, Do, Study, Act framework to ensure strategies and impact are routinely reviewed by staff and refined over time.





Our Anchor pathway is offered to those who require a more bespoke curriculum approach, with a smaller cohort of peers. Young people on this pathway are selected through working with feeder primary schools and the SEND departments review of those with more acute needs.

We also provide strategic literacy interventions for young people related to sentence completion, passage comprehension and phonic needs.

Tavistock College Sixth Form offers a broad range of academic A levels and vocational courses to meet the needs of our community. We pride ourselves on offering the highest quality teaching and learning, and we ensure all students receive clear advice and guidance to enable our young people to progress smoothly onto their chosen career paths in both the academic and professional worlds.

We also offer a bespoke Level 2 programme combining a Level 2 Business qualification, an Enterprise Prince's Trust course and retakes in English and Maths, for those young people who just miss out on the entry requirements for Level 3 courses.





Young people are encouraged to take part in a wealth of opportunities to challenge themselves and develop as individuals. Each young person is allocated a staff mentor who will guide and support them over the two years that they are in 6th form.

We also ensure that our young people continue to develop their knowledge of PHSE and RSE in order to equip them for their futures.

All 6th form young people have the opportunity to participate in a student leadership programme whereby they support the lower school in a range of activities.

# FUTURES






