Create revision posters for key themes: violence, gang culture, guilt, victimhood

Revise disfluency as a key language feature

Revise Leah's monologues

Use the study booklet on SMHW to revise context, character and theme.

Revise four poems in detail – creating revision posters – make sure you have solid contextual details for each
